# **Discover the proud cities of the Altmark**



Experiences, excitement and enjoyment in the wide open spaces of the Altmark: the idyllic countryside in the north of Saxony-Anhalt is just waiting to be explored. The historic Hanseatic cities are surrounded by woods and fields. Particular highlights are the eight cities in the Altmark that belonged to the Hanseatic League. They are spread throughout the region and still play an important part in the league today. The Altmark countryside can be discovered on foot, by bike or on horseback.

The main culinary delicacy of the Altmark is the Salzwedel Baumkuchen or tree cake. This sweet specialty is still made locally by individual bakers and in small factories. The perfect way to try this delicacy is in one of the many cafés in the region with a cup of coffee or tea.

### **MORNING:** THE HANSEATIC TOWN OF TANGERMÜNDE

The River Elbe shimmers in the morning sun, which also lights up the facades of the buildings in the medieval town of Tangermünde. The town lies in the north-east of Saxony-Anhalt. This is the place where our day spent discovering the Altmark begins and also where the Rivers Tanger and Elbe meet. The UNESCO Middle Elbe Biosphere Reserve is just outside this idyllic little town and the Elbe Cycle Route passes close by. On a guided tour of the town, visitors can find out more about its history and about how it became an imperial residence and a Hanseatic town. If you are visiting, make sure that you don't miss the view from Tangermünde Castle.

### **AFTERNOON: HANSESTADT STENDAL**
