Family adventure day in Halle (Saale)



Halle has a huge amount to offer families with children. There are attractions, theater performances, cafés, museums, events and guided tours, all aimed at children. A cycle ride along the Saale, a stroll through the inner city or a boat ride across the river – Halle offers a variety of experiences and has a wide range of activities available. The green spaces in the city that is Handel's birthplace are the ideal locations for activities in the midst of the hustle and bustle of urban life. In addition to the Botanical Gardens, the Amtsgarten and Gimritzer Park, there is also Peißnitz Island in the River Saale, which is the perfect place to meet for open air sport, games and picnics. The adventure program for a one-day visit can be adapted depending on the weather and the visitors' preferences to make sure that everyone has fun.

Special highlights include the Halloren Chocolate World of Experience, boat trips, cultural events, wellness offerings and the DB Museum for railway lovers.

MORNING: VISIT TO THE BERGZOO HALLE

There is an exciting start to the day with a visit to the "Bergzoo Halle", which is home to almost 1700 animals of more than 250 species from five continents. The collection at the spacious site focuses on mountain animals and the flora of South America. Children will be captivated by the sloths, flamingos and meerkats.
