# **Historic Magdeburg**



The magnificent medieval cathedral of Magdeburg towers over the city of Otto. It is a landmark that can be seen from a long distance away, above the baroque facades, green spaces and colorful roofs of the city. It reminds visitors of the city's 1200-year history. This is the first Gothic cathedral built on German soil. The impressive structure is a memorial to Emperor Otto I, whose remains are interred inside. The other famous Otto in Magdeburg, Otto von Guericke, is remembered in the name of the city's university.

The cathedral is surrounded by historic and modern buildings and by the River Elbe which can be heard flowing past. Culture, art and history are closely interwoven in the city. Examples of this include the Art Museum Monastery of Our Lady, the Green Citadel of the architect Friedensreich Hundertwasser, the fortifications of Ravelin 2 and the remains of the historic city walls in the center.

### MORNING: EXPLORING THE CITY

A variety of brightly colored buildings and spacious squares lead visitors into the center of Magdeburg where its hidden corners are revealed. The Cathedral Square in the heart of the city is the perfect starting point for an exploratory tour. The square is surrounded by buildings from a range of different eras and architectural styles. Opposite the cathedral is the entrancing pink structure known as the Green Citadel. With its crooked facades, green roofs and colorful spheres, the building is the final project of the world-famous architect Friedensreich Hundertwasser. From the roof of the Green Citadel there is a spectacular panoramic view of the city with its fortifications and many green spaces. The River Elbe can also be clearly seen. Historic features are found everywhere in the city of Magdeburg.

The park, located on its own island in the Elbe, is home to many show pieces of Magdeburg modernism. Visitors can also take a rowing boat or a pedalo out on Adolf Mittag Lake.

A trip around the city on a red double-decker bus or a guided tour on foot will bring to life the exciting history of Magdeburg and visitors will discover many interesting facts along the way. The Tourist Information Center has all the information you will need to make the most of your visit to Magdeburg.
