The wide variety of leisure and culture offerings ranges from the Elbauen Park in Magdeburg, the Storchenhof stork observatory and the "Rittergut von Barby" manor house and café in Loburg through to the "Bierer Berg Zoo".

# **MORNING: PÖMMELTE WOODHENGE**

South of Magdeburg and on the outskirts of the town of Schönebeck are the remains of a circular ditch structure that is more than 4000 years old and has been reconstructed on its original site. The Pömmelte Woodhenge, which dates back to the late Stone Age, is open to visitors and has plenty of interesting discoveries for both adults and children to make.
