World Heritage Region of Anhalt-Dessau-Wittenberg



Within a radius of only 35 kilometers, you will find three UNESCO World Heritage Sites and one UNESCO Biosphere Reserve: the Luther Memorials in Wittenberg, the Bauhaus, the Masters' Houses and the Houses with Balcony Access in Dessau-Roßlau, the Garden Kingdom of Dessau-Wörlitz and the UNESCO Middle Elbe Biosphere Reserve.

The World Heritage Region also has plenty to offer lovers of water sports. The Rivers Elbe, Saale and Mulde, together with idyllic lakes such as Goitzsche Lake, Muldestau Lake, Gremmin Lake, Gröbern Lake, Bergwitz Lake and Edderitz Lake, all have a variety of water sports activities available, including a modern wakepark and two passenger ships. They are also ideal places to spend a few relaxing hours. The region can also be explored on horseback or in a horse-drawn wagon. Escape from the everyday grind and discover the Anhalt-Dessau-Wittenberg region in the way that best suits you.

One tip for visitors: Explore the region with a "WelterbeCard" (World Heritage card) which offers free entry or other discounts in many visitor attractions.

MORNING: TOUR OF WITTENBERG

Historical highlights of the Reformation are scattered all over Wittenberg, but there are also other interesting destinations worth discovering if you decide to take a tour of the town. You can visit the Piesteritz workers' estate, the first and largest car-free residential settlement in Germany, where the architecture is highly impressive. Another highlight is the Coal | Steam | Light | Lakes cycle route that starts at the Piesteritz workers' estate. One essential destination on an architecture tour is the Hundertwasser school building, which is home to the Luther Melanchthon High School. The Tourist Information Center in Wittenberg can provide you with details of all these sights and many other attractions.

Lutherstadt Wittenberg is home to many interesting sights within a very small radius. During a stroll along the main street in the picturesque old district of the town, visitors will pass many of Wittenberg's cultural highlights. At one end is the Castle Church with the world-famous door where Martin Luther nailed his theses, while only a stone's throw away is the Town Church of St. Mary where he preached for 30 years.
